### **AUSTRALIA**

Australia is the world's sixth-largest country and the only one that is also a continent. Its landscape ranges from vast deserts and tropical rainforests to stunning beaches and vibrant cities. The capital is Canberra, while the largest city is Sydney, followed by Melbourne, Brisbane, and Perth.



Australia has a multicultural society, with people speaking more than 150 different languages. It boasts a strong economy, a high quality of life, and a rich Indigenous heritage, with history dating back over 65,000 years.

### **VICTORIA**

Victoria is Australia's second-most populous state, with Melbourne as its capital. It is known for its cultural diversity, vibrant arts scene, and strong education sector. Victoria has the highest number of universities compared to other Australian states, with 10 universities, while Australia as a whole has 43 universities, making it a major hub for higher education and research.

Melbourne offers an exciting student life with world -class institutions, diverse cultural experiences, and numerous cafes, festivals, and study-friendly spaces.

### **ACCOMODATION**

Accommodation expenses vary based on location and living arrangements. Many universities provide affordable student housing options, with prices ranging from \$420 - \$860. These accommodations offer convenience and a supportive community for students.

Private rentals are also an option, with average weekly prices starting from \$425 – \$525 in metropolitan Melbourne and \$260 – \$500 in regional Victoria.

#### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is mandatory health insurance for international students studying in Australia. It helps cover medical and hospital costs, with premiums typically ranging from \$550 to \$1,000 per year.



### PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport costs in Melbourne typically range from \$30 - \$60 per week. International students are eligible for a 50% discount on public transport fares. Public Transport Victoria (PTV) operates and manages the city's transport system. Trams are the p rimary mode of transport in the Central Business District (CBD), while buses and trains serve the outer suburbs. Regional stations are serviced by V/Line.



### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

A minimum level of English proficiency is required for both visa application and university admission. The following tests are accepted:

- → International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic
- → Pearson Test of English (PTE)
- → Certificate of Advanced English (CAE)
- → Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)

# **MASTERS OF COURSEWORK**

- → Focus: Taught program with structured subjects, practical learning, and assessments.
- → Structure: Includes lectures, assignments, and exams, often with a capstone project.
- → Assessment: Based on assignments, exams, and projects rather than a thesis.

### **MASTERS OF RESEARCH**

- → Focus: Emphasizes independent research and academic inquiry.
- → Structure: Involves a research thesis, literature review, and some coursework related to research methodologies.
- → Assessment: Based on a thesis or dissertation, with minimal coursework.

### **Details:**

**Melbourne Research Scholarship** - Available for high-achieving students enrolling in a graduate research degree.

- → Scholarship: 100% fee remission and up to \$135,000, covering tuition for two years (Masters by Research) or four years (Doctoral degree).
- → Stipend: \$38,500 per year, including limited paid sick, parental, and partner leave.
- → Relocation Allowance: \$3,000 for those moving from overseas.
- → Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for international students needing a student visa.

**AG Whitlam Graduate Merit Scholarship** - Available for students enrolling in Master's by Coursework at Melbourne Business School.

→ Scholarship: 50% fee remission for the duration of the course.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

Melbourne Research Scholarship -

- → Completion of a four-year Australian Bachelor's degree or an overseas equivalent.
- → Overall average of more than 75% in the final year.
- → Completion of a research project/component accounting for at least 25% of the year's work at the 4th-year undergraduate or Master's level.

**AG Whitlam Graduate Merit Scholarship** - Available for students enrolling in Master's by Coursework at Melbourne Business School.

- → Must have completed an undergraduate degree.
- → Specialization or major in the selected subject is required.

# **Scholarship Details:**

**Master of Commerce Scholarship** - The Master of Commerce (MCom) is a research -focused program leading to a PhD.

→ Scholarship covers tuition fees + \$36,063 annual stipend (up to 2 years).

**Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Science International Merit Scholarship** - Available for commencing international students in the Master of Pharmaceutical Science program.

→ 50% tuition fee coverage per year for the highest-achieving student → 25% tuition fee coverage per year for the second highest-achieving student → Maintain a Weighted Average Mark of 70 each semester to retain scholarship.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

#### Master of Commerce Scholarship -

- → Seeking to enrol full-time, in the Master of Commerce degree
- → You are not eligible for this scholarship if you are, or become, employed on a continuing basis or a fixed term contract for 3 months or greater.
- → Selected based on outstanding academic achievement, interest in a research career in the relevant discipline and interview performance.

#### Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Science International Merit Scholarship -

→ An Australian bachelor degree 2 years full time, 4 years part time. (or equivalent) in Pharmacy or Science or Biomedical Science or Engineering (in an appropriate discipline e.g. Pharmaceutical, Chemical, Biomedical or Materials) with at least a credit (60%) average.

**Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Science International Merit Scholarship** - No separate application required for scholarship

# **Scholarship Details:**

**RMIT Research International Tuition Fee Scholarship** - Available for high-achieving students enrolling in a graduate research degree.

- → Provide tuition fees for two years (Masters by Research) or four years (Doctoral degree).
- → Stipend of \$35,886 per annum
- → Paid sick, maternity and parenting leave
- → Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for international students needing a student visa.

→ A relocation allowance up to \$515 per adult and \$255 per child to a maximum of \$1,540

**Irana Turynska Scholarship** - Available for students enrolling in 2025 in 1st year of Master of Architecture (MC163) (coursework)

→ This scholarship provides up to \$10,000 per annum for up to one year.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

RMIT Research International Tuition Fee Scholarship -

- → Completion of a four-year Australian Bachelor's degree or an overseas equivalent.
- → Overall average of more than 60% or higher.
- → Completion of a research project/component accounting for at least 25% of a full time (or part time equivalent) academic year.
- → Priority Given To Applicants Who achieved high distinction (80% or higher) in the final two years of their qualifying program, have equivalent academic attainment through previous study, work experience, research publications, etc. → Evidence of appropriate academic qualifications and/or experience.

### Irana Turynska Scholarship -

- → Identify as a woman and resided in Australia for less than 10 years.
- → Australian architecture specific bachelor degree (or equivalent overseas qualification).
- → Selected competitively based on your grades and selection task.
- → Minimum GPA of 2.5 in Bachelor of Architectural Design (as of Semester 2, 2024)
